

## Scholarships for Students

1. **Tall Clubs International Scholarship –**

If you're a male 6' 2" or taller, or a female 5' 10" or taller, you just may qualify for this \$1,000 scholarship. To qualify, you simply need to write an essay entitled "What Being Tall Means to Me."

2. **Scholar Athlete Milk Mustache of the Year (SAMMY) Award –**

This \$7,500 scholarship, free trip to Disney World and spot in a Milk Mustache and are available to 25 student-athlete high school seniors with 3.20 GPAs who participate in school or club sports.

3. **Van Valkenburg Memorial Scholarship –**

You can win \$1,000 if you're a descendant through birth or legal adoption of Lambert and Annetje Van Valkenburg.

4. **Duck Brand Duct Tape Stuck on Prom Contest –**

Who would ever think that creating prom outfits out of duct tape could win a lucky couple \$3,000 in scholarship money?

5. **American Welding Society Scholarships –**

Are you a talented welder – or have an interest in being one? If so, you may be eligible for welding scholarships that could help pay for education in soldering, brazing, joining and thermal spraying.

6. **Society of Vacuum Coaters Foundation Scholarship –**

\$2,500 is awarded to one or more students annually who love the art of vacuum coating. Is this for you?

7. **Sophie Major Memorial Duck Calling Contest –**

If you love ducks season you may be eligible for \$2,000 in scholarships. So get your favorite duck call and get prepared to win some money!

8. **Excellence in Predicting the Future Award –**

You don't have to be a fortune teller to win this \$400 award. You just need to be good at predicting the financial market and have a desire for economics.

9. **Common Knowledge Challenges –**

If you know a lot about a lot then you may be eligible for a series of Common Knowledge Scholarships that range from \$250 – \$3,000.

10. **National Make It Yourself Wool Competition –**

Do you consider yourself a fashion guru with a special taste for wool? If so, you may qualify for one of four scholarships with the American Sheep Industry.

11. **Discover Scholarship Award –**

This scholarship for high school juniors requires a 2.75 GPA and proof of a significant roadblock to earn \$40,000 for post-high school education, training, certification or licensing.

12. **Alice Mcarver Ratchford Scholarship** –  
This special scholarship goes to single female undergraduate students in financial need who live on campus, don't have a car and no other scholarships.
13. **KLI Academic Award: The Kor Memorial Scholarship** –  
If you're a "Trekky" then you'll love this \$500 scholarship from the Klingon Language Institute for students in the field of language study. Luckily, you don't need to know Klingon to qualify!
14. **Dannie Jasmine Mule Deer Foundation Scholarship** –  
This \$500 scholarship is eligible to students who love of nature, are enrolled at University of Nevada, Reno and have studied Environmental and Resources Science for at least two semesters.
15. **School Bank and Orchestra Magazine Scholarship** –  
By writing a simple essay you could qualify for \$1,000 in scholarship money. 2009's entry essay is "I believe music must remain a part of the school curriculum because."
16. **American Association of Candy Technologists Scholarship** –  
College sophomores, juniors and seniors could qualify for \$5,000 in scholarship funds if they carry a 3.0 GPA and major in food science or other related areas. Sounds like a sweet deal!
17. **Writers and Illustrators of the Future Contest** –  
If you didn't get the Klingon Scholarship, you may qualify for this contest that awards student authors and illustrators in the genre of Science Fiction.
18. **Ayn Rand The Fountainhead Scholarship** –  
If you enjoyed the book The Fountainhead by Ayn Rand and are in the 11th or 12th grade, you could receive up to \$10,000 in scholarship money by writing the best essay concerning the novel.
19. **Hood College Heritage Scholarship** –  
If you have a parent or grandparent who received a bachelor's degree from Hood College, you may be eligible for a \$5,000 one-year scholarship.
20. **OP Loftbed Scholarship** –  
This \$500 scholarship only requires that you attend an accredited college or university and answer a few quirky questions (ex. What will you type in your next TEXT, Tweet, or Instant Message to your best friend?).
21. **Evans Scholars Foundation Scholarship** –  
Golf lovers could benefit from this WGA-sponsored scholarship that gives young caddies with financial need (and a great caddie record) the opportunity to pay for college.
22. **Eileen J. Garrett Scholarship** –  
The desire to study parapsychology along with proof that you've written about it before is all you need to qualify for this \$3,000 scholarship.
23. **United States Bowling Congress (USBA) Scholarships** –  
USBA offers a number of scholarships to bowling fans with dollar amounts ranging from \$1,000 to \$2,500.
24. **Surfrider Foundation Scholarship Program** –  
This grassroots organizations awards scholarships to undergrads, grads and PH-D students who are members of the Surfrider Foundation.

25. **Michigan Llama Association (MLA) Scholarship –**  
Being an MLA member or being the child of a member is all you need to qualify for this scholarship.
26. **Tylenol Scholarship –**  
Tylenol offers \$5,000 to \$10,000 awards to 40 lucky students each year. How to qualify? Desire a career in the medical field.
27. **American Fire Sprinkler Association Scholarship –**  
High school students who don't mind reading an essay about fire sprinklers then taking a 10-question test could qualify for a \$2,000 scholarship.
28. **Collegiate Inventors Competition –**  
Students who have been enrolled full-time at a U.S. or Canadian college or university for at least 12 months and have a new idea, process or technology could qualify for \$15,000 in scholarship money.
29. **LaFontaine Aquatic Entomology Scholarship –**  
The Federation of Fly Fishers (FFF) \$500 scholarship is for aquatic entomology lovers and scholars performing research in the field.
30. **Mycological Society of America Scholarships –**  
\$2,000 scholarships are available to students, teachers and researchers who study mycology (the study of fungi).
31. **Hiram College Hal Reichle Scholarship –**  
Talk about quirky. This scholarship comes from the Secret Society of Serendipitous Service to Hal (SSSSH), which loves students dedicated to community service.

**Chick Evans Caddie Scholarship- Application Deadlines:**

September 30, Annually. The Chick Evans Caddie Scholarship is a grant that covers tuition and housing (when applicable) in an Evans Scholarship House and may be renewed for up to four years at the Foundation's option. Applicants must meet the following requirements: - Caddie - Academic - Financial Need - Character

**Theeile Kor Memorial Scholarship - Application Deadlines:**

June 01, Annually. The purpose of the Kor Memorial Scholarship is to recognize and encourage scholarship in fields of language study. Familiarity with Klingon or other constructed languages is not required, however creative and innovative applicants are preferred. A \$500 award will be bestowed upon an undergraduate or graduate student each year.

32. **National Candy Technologists Scholarship**-Application Deadlines: April 12, Annually.  
The scholarship award for the recipient is \$5,000, paid in two \$2,500 installments after verification of enrollment. To qualify for this non-renewing scholarship award, the student must:  
- Be either a college sophomore, junior or senior for the upcoming academic year.
33. **LaFontaine Aquatic Entomology Scholarship**-Application Deadlines: April 01, Annually.  
This grant was created to honor Gary LaFontaine and the aquatic entomology he loved and spent his life studying. A fund has been established in the Federation of Fly Fishers Foundation, to support graduate students (MS or PhD) doing a research project in aquatic entomology.

### **U.S. DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION - Student Aid on the Web**

34. **FAFSA** - Free Application for Federal Student Aid

Submit electronically the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). All students interested in financial aid for college will need to complete this form.

#### **Pell Grants for Low-Income Undergraduates.**

A Federal Pell Grant, unlike a loan, does not have to be repaid. Pell Grants are awarded usually only to undergraduate students who have not earned a bachelor's or a professional degree.

#### **Federal Perkins Loans for Undergraduate, Vocational and Graduate Students**

The Federal Perkins Loan Program provides low-interest loans to help needy students finance the costs of postsecondary education. Students can receive Perkins loans at any one of approximately 1,800 participating postsecondary institutions.

35. **Direct Student Loans**

Students and parents can explore the site for information about the Direct Loan Program, including helpful publications and tools to help manage their Direct Loans.

36. **Presidential Scholars** - the Most Distinguished High School Seniors

The U.S. Presidential Scholars Program recognizes and honors some of our nation's most distinguished graduating high school seniors, including students who demonstrate exceptional talent in the visual, creative and performing arts.

### **RONALD REAGAN PRESIDENTIAL FOUNDATION AND LIBRARY - Scholarship Programs**

37. **GE-Reagan Foundation Scholarship Program-**

Each year, the Program selects numerous high school seniors attending high school in the United States to receive a \$10,000 scholarship renewable for up to an additional three years - up to \$40,000 total per recipient. Awards are for undergraduate study only, and may be used for education-related expenses, including tuition, fees, books, supplies, room, and board. In addition, Scholars are invited to participate in a special awards program.

38. **Reagan Presidential Foundation Scholars Program-**

The Reagan Presidential Foundation Scholars Program awards Ventura County, Calif., high school seniors who exemplify outstanding leadership skills and personal character with a total of \$50,000 in scholarships annually. Each recipient will receive an amount ranging from \$2,000 to \$10,000 in college scholarships and will attend an awards ceremony in Simi Valley, California. The two highest monetary awards each include a \$500 grant that the recipient will give to the teacher of their choice.

39. **MCDONALD'S, RONALD MCDONALD HOUSE CHARITIES -**

U.S. Scholarships. Scholarships for Graduating, College-Bound High School Seniors. All students are eligible to apply regardless of race, color, creed, religion, sexual orientation, gender, disability or national origin, must be a high school senior, be younger than 21 years old, be

eligible to attend a two- or four-year college, university or technical school with a full course of study, and be a legal U.S. resident.

40. **BURGER KING McLAMORE FOUNDATION - Scholars Program.**

Burger King Scholarships for Graduating, College Bound High School Seniors. Scholarships for current high school senior who will be enrolling full-time in the fall of the scholarship year.

42. **MICHAEL & SUSAN DELL FOUNDATION - Urban Education.**

Dell Scholarships for College-Bound High School Seniors. Unlike many other college scholarships, the Dell Scholars Program recognizes academic potential and determination in students that have a definite need for financial assistance. The Dell Scholars Program is available to students participating in approved college readiness/college access programs. 43. **DAVIDSON INSTITUTE FOR TALENT DEVELOPMENT -**

Programs for Students. Davidson Fellows Scholarships for Young People under the Age of 18 Who Have Completed a Significant Piece Of Work. Scholarships to extraordinary young people under the age of 18 who have completed a significant piece of work.

44. **NATIONAL MERIT SCHOLARSHIP CORPORATION (NMSC) -**

National Merit College Scholarships. College Scholarships for High School Seniors. The National Merit Scholarship Program is an academic competition for recognition and scholarships. Special Scholarships for High School Seniors. National Merit Program participants, who are outstanding but not Finalists, are awarded Special Scholarships provided by corporations and business organizations. To be considered for a Special Scholarship, students must meet the sponsor's criteria and entry requirements of the National Merit Scholarship Program.

45. **IMAGINE AMERICA FOUNDATION -**

Education Scholarships. Scholarships for College Bound High School Seniors. Each year, every high school in the United States and Puerto Rico may nominate up to five graduating seniors to receive an Imagine America scholarship.

46. **SAE INTERNATIONAL FOUNDATION - Scholarships Program.** Scholarships for High School Seniors

These scholarships encourage academic excellence and help students around the world to pursue their passion for engineering.

47. **ELKS NATIONAL FOUNDATION – Scholarships.**

Most Valuable Student Scholarships for High School Seniors, The Elks National Foundation will award four-year scholarships to the highest-rated high school senior applicants.

48. **NATIONAL HONOR SOCIETY - Scholarships and Awards.**

National Honor Society Scholarships for High School Seniors. The NHS Scholarship Program awards scholarships to outstanding NHS members.

49. **AMERICAN METEOROLOGICAL SOCIETY - Scholarships and Fellowships.**

AMS Freshman Undergraduate Scholarships. The scholarship program is open to all high school students and designed to encourage study in the atmospheric and related sciences.

**50. AMERICAN SOCIETY OF HEATING, REFRIGERATING AND AIR-CONDITIONING ENGINEERS - Scholarships and Grants.**

High School Senior Scholarships. Available to college freshmen enrolled full-time in an undergraduate pre-engineering or engineering technology program leading to a bachelor's degree in a course of study that traditionally has been a preparatory curriculum for the HVAC&R profession.

**51. ARMY SCHOLARSHIP FOUNDATION-College Scholarships for High School Seniors**

The Army Scholarship Foundation awards one-year financial scholarships (not grants or loans) on an annual basis to qualified and deserving students.

**52. AXA FOUNDATION-AXA Achievement<sup>SM</sup> Scholarships for High School Seniors**

The AXA Achievement<sup>SM</sup> Scholarship offers college scholarships to high school seniors who have demonstrated outstanding achievement in their activities in school, the community or the workplace.

**53. BEST BUY - Scholarships-Scholarships for Students in Grades 9-12.**

Applicants must be students currently in grades 9-12 living in the United States or Puerto Rico who will be attending a college, university or vocational school in the fall immediately following their high school graduation.

**54. BOETTCHER FOUNDATION – Scholarships. College Scholarships for Colorado High School Seniors**

Selection criteria include superior scholastic ability, evidence of leadership & involvement, service to community, and school outstanding character.

**55. BUICK ACHIEVERS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM- College Scholarships for First-Time Freshman or Existing College Students.**

A dedicated student. A leader in school. A volunteer worker. A college-bound and community-minded individual. The Buick Achievers Scholarship Program wants to reward students who have succeeded both inside and outside of the classroom and who may not be able to attend college without financial assistance. It's a reward for what you've made of yourself and the difference you are making for others. Scholarships are renewable up to four years and one additional year for those entering a qualified five-year engineering program.

**60. FEDERAL EMPLOYEE EDUCATION & ASSISTANCE FUND (FEEA)-**

Scholarships for Current Civilian Federal or Postal Employees and Their Dependent Family Members. FEEA sponsors the only merit-based scholarship competition program open exclusively to federal employees, their spouses, and their children--rewarding hard workers through our merit-based program.

**61. FIRST (FOR INSPIRATION AND RECOGNITION OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY) - Scholarship Program.** College Scholarships for High School Seniors. FIRST scholarships enable students to pursue majors and careers in engineering, computer science, science, math, design, aeronautics, and many other fields.

**62. HARVARD UNIVERSITY - Financial Aid**

Harvard Financial Aid Initiative- To be considered under HFAI, students must apply to and gain admission to Harvard College. **63. HORATIO ALGER ASSOCIATION - Scholarship Programs.**

Scholarships for College Bound High School Seniors. For students in financial need who are currently in their senior year of high school and graduating in the spring.

**64. INTEL EDUCATION INITIATIVE – Competitions.**

Intel Science Talent Search for High School Seniors - Up to \$100,000 College Scholarships. America's oldest and most prestigious pre-college science competition.

**65. KFC - Colonel's Scholars Program.**

**70. NATIONAL EAGLE SCOUT ASSOCIATION (NESA)-**

College Scholarships for Eagle Scouts Graduating High School and Entering College. NESA academic scholarship applicants must be Eagle Scouts graduating high school and entering college in the year for which they apply for a scholarship.

**71. NATIONAL RESTAURANT ASSOCIATION EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION - Scholarship Program**

Academic Scholarships for High School Seniors. This scholarship is for students who will be first-time freshmen including graduating high school seniors, GED graduates and high school graduates enrolling in college for the first time.

**72. ProStart® Certificate of Achievement Scholarships for High School Seniors -**

Accepted to Foodservice Education Programs. Scholarships for motivated individuals who are committed to furthering their education and succeeding in the restaurant and foodservice industry.

**73. NORDSTROM-**
